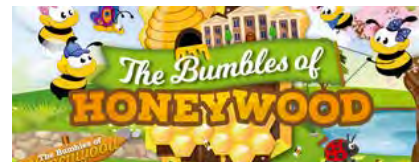


BIKEABILITY
